<b>Chord</b>	More than one note being played at once
<b>Improvisation</b>	To make it up as you go along
<b>Layering</b>	To add texture, instruments added
<b>Loops</b>	To go round again

Musical Terms	
<b>Beat/Pulse</b>	The steady pulse that keeps going through a piece of music like a clock.
<b>Rhythm</b>	Patterns of long and short sounds used in music.
<b>Tempo</b>	How fast or slow the music is. The tempo can change during a piece of music.
<b>Dynamics</b>	How loud or quiet music sounds. Dynamics can change during a piece of music.
<b>Texture</b>	Sections where there are fewer performers and sections where there are more performers.
<b>Pitch</b>	How high or low a note sounds.
